EDUCATION

Girls go to Amcha Ghar English medium school in the village up to class VII. Others go to schools at Bhayander and Gorai. For them fees structure is very expensive for us. No. of children distributed in different classes as follows.

Std VII: 4 Std VIII : 3

IX: 1 (Bhayander)

X: 2 (Open school - Gorai)
