STORY OF TWO SISTERS

Deepa (6) & Diya (12) (name changed), two sisters lived with their Grandmother in slums of Mumbai. Their father expired due to alcoholism & their mother ran away after her husband's death. Deepa & Diya's grandmother took responsibility of them after their parents. She does housework at 2-3 houses to survive the family. While she goes to work she is helpless as she has to leave them at home all by themselves. The area that they live in isn't safe for the girls.

The grandmother admitted both the girls at Amcha Ghar on the order of Child Welfare Committee (CWC) in 2018. These girls are happy at Amcha Ghar as they are given English Medium education, proper nutrition, medical facilities & various needs are taken care off.

Deepa is in Sr.Kg & Diya is in 4th Standard now. Diya has an amazing grasping power due to which we were able to move all the classes upto 4th std due to her age. They have accepted Amcha Ghar as their own family.

AMCHA GHAR BALGRUH



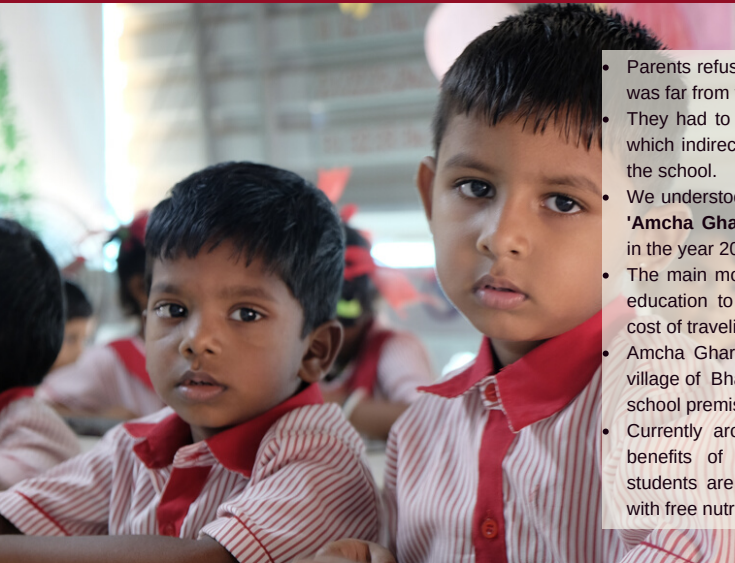
- Home for Girls from age group 6-18 years
- Provide residence, English Medium education, medical, recreation, self-defense and spiritual facilities in a homely atmosphere to the girls
- Aims to provide an atmosphere that promotes holistic development of orphan and semi-orphan girls in a residential home.
- Make the girls capable enough to join back to the main stream of the society after she has completed 18 years of age
- Functions under the Juvenile Justice Act (J J Act).
- The girls that come to Amcha Ghar are under the sanction order from the Child Welfare Committee (CWC).
- Around 800+ girls have been rehabilitated to the main stream of the society through marriage, further education like MBA, Hotel Mgmt, IATA, CA, Civil Engineering, BMS, etc.

AMCHA GHAR ENGLISH HIGH SCHOOL & JUNIOR COLLEGE



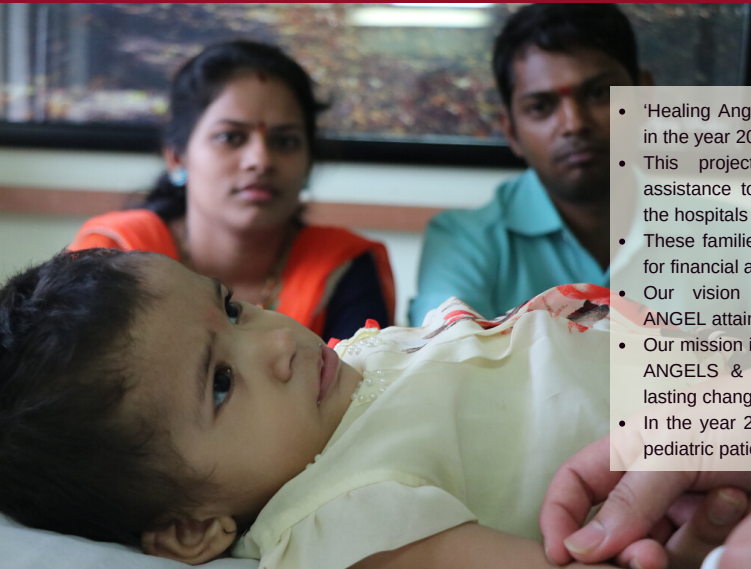
- We believe in providing education to the grass-root level of the society with an aim to empower them, which in return helps to eradicate poverty, unemployment, child labor, etc.
- Amcha Ghar started its own high school & Junior college, namely '**Amcha Ghar English School & Junior college of Arts, Commerce & Science**' for the under-privilege children of the village.
- The main aim is to bridge the gap between the rich & poor & promote holistic development of the students.
- Amcha Ghar has supported almost 2000+ students till date by providing them English Medium Education.
- We have purchased our own school bus to transport kids to school who can't afford to travel through public transports due to sheer poverty and miss out on education.
- We provide professional training to our teaching staff from time to time of how to make their class more productive & active, which in turn will create lasting impact on the students.

GROUP OF PRE-PRIMARY SCHOOLS (ENGLISH MEDIUM)



- Parents refused to send their kids to school as the school was far from their home.
- They had to use public transport to travel to the school, which indirectly was an additional expense to the fees of the school.
- We understood the needs of the parents and thus started '**Amcha Ghar group of Pre-Primary English Schools**' in the year 2014.
- The main motive was to provide quality English medium education to them at their doorstep, thus reducing the cost of traveling.
- Amcha Ghar has opened 5 Pre-Primary Schools in the village of Bhatia, Pali, Morva, Murdha khadi, and at main school premises.
- Currently around 200+ students, take advantage of the benefits of the group of Pre-Primary Schools. The students are given education at subsidized rates along with free nutrition and recreation.

HEALING ANGELS (MEDICAL SUPPORT)



- 'Healing Angles' an Amcha Ghar initiative, was started in the year 2018.
- This project mainly aims at providing financial assistance to the poor children (Pediatric Patients) in the hospitals that are financially challenged.
- These families are from around India that approach us for financial assistance.
- Our vision is to create a world in which every little ANGEL attains the right to survival.
- Our mission is to improve the quality of life of these little ANGELS & their families and achieve immediate & lasting change in their lives.
- In the year 2019-20, this project has helped almost 50 pediatric patients

CARING ANGELS (SENIOR CITIZEN SUPPORT)



- Amcha Ghar commenced the project of 'Caring Angels' for the senior citizens below the poverty line living in miserable conditions.
- These grandparents have been neglected by their own children and grandchildren and left alone to fend for themselves.
- We aim at providing them with nutrition, clothing, medical aid, etc.
- As we do not have our own premises yet, the care is provided to the caring angels at their own homes.

- These children live in unhygienic conditions, without proper food, clothing and other basic necessities.

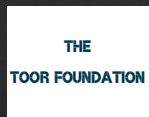
